- multiple activities can happen at the same time

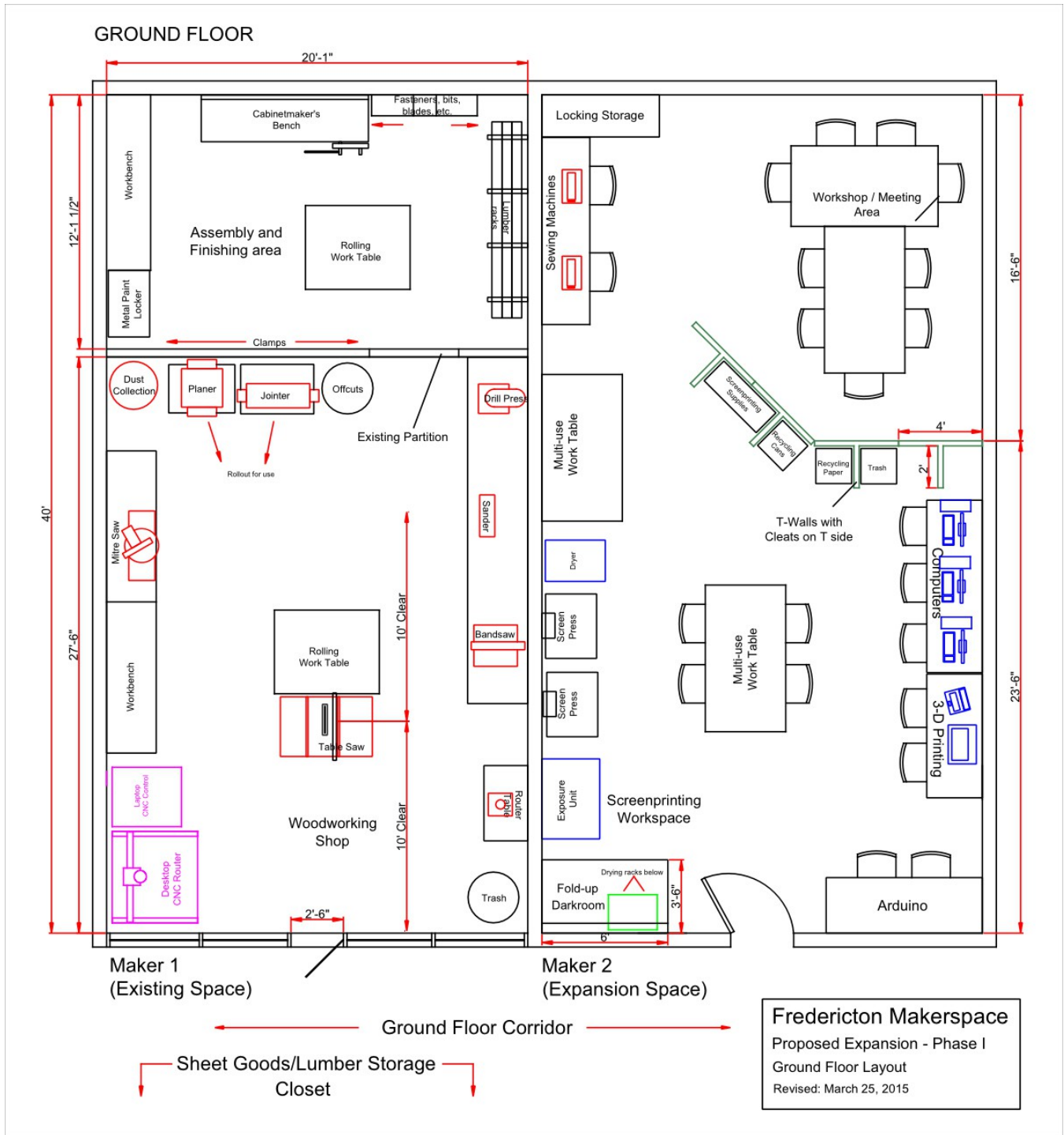
